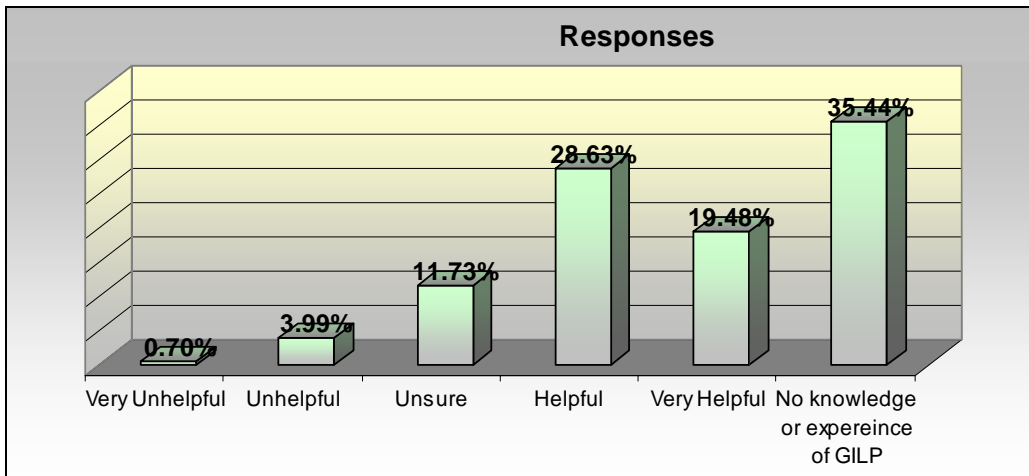


Graduate Research School Survey of Higher Degree Research Students 2006

Earlier this year the Graduate Research School undertook a survey of the HDR students to find out what services they are using on campus and how successful the services are. The Question on the Graduate Information Literacy program read, "How helpful has (GILP) been in contributing to your professional development?" 447 responses were received and 426 respondents answered this question. The major concern to GILP is the large number of students who still claim they have either no knowledge of or experience with the GILP program. 35.44%. It would have been interesting to GILP to have had this category split into either "No Knowledge" or "No Experience" as we could then have determined if our marketing strategies were inadequate.



What is encouraging is to take a closer look at the responses of the students who had participated in GILP programs. 205 of the 275 students reported that GILP had contributed to their professional development.
